GENERAL MAINTENANCE FOR FOUNTAINS

1. When first installed, if filled drain and dry. Then spray or brush on Thompson Waterseal (at Walmart or Ace Hardware) on fountain and then every six months.
2. Sponge out dirt at least once a month and put in fresh water.
3. Put a few drops of Algaecide #10 (at Home Depot) once a week. In general, this will control the green algae. Stay away from products with a higher chlorine content than 10% as this could damage the pump and fountain.
4. Do not run fountain 24 hours a day. Turn off at night and before starting in the morning fill up all bowls to replace evaporation.
5. Don't put fountain on a timer unless it has a waterline float in it.
6. Make sure screen on the pump stays free of leaves or other debris that could clog it.
7. Keep empty box and keep receipt in it as you have a year warranty on pump as long as it has not been run dry.
8. Average life of the pump is 3-5 years with proper maintenance.
9. Handle the fountain with care. They are concrete but can chip like fine China if banged against a hard surface.
10. If you have a drip line in the area of the fountain put it into the back of the fountain also.
11. In the summer do not run for more than 5-6 hours a day as the water is warmer and doesn't cool the pump as well.
12. In the winter do not run for more than 7-8 hours a day.
13. The fuller you keep the water level the cooler the pump is when running.
14. When you go away for a week or longer, empty fountain and unplug. If you have a water line, turn it off or if a drip line, cap it.
